

STUDENT USER AGREEMENT VIOLATION

District Wide Violation Procedures for Students

First Offense (per school year):

1. Written report sent to District Computer Coordinator.
2. Loss of computer/media equipment privileges for 5 school days.
3. Written report of violation submitted to the building administrator.
4. Letter sent to parents with copies to the building administrator and to the Technology director.

Second Offense (per school year):

1. Written report sent to District Computer Coordinator.
2. Conference with building administrator.
3. ISS for 3 days, if building level appropriate, and loss of 5 additional days of computer usage.
4. Letter sent to parents with copies of infraction reports for the first and second offenses.

Third Offense (per school year):

1. Written report sent to District Computer Coordinator.
2. Loss of computer/media equipment privileges for the remainder of class enrollment and ten days ISS.
3. Letter sent to parents with copies of infraction reports for the first through third offenses.

Severity Clause: The district reserves the right to waive any or all of the above procedures depending on severity of infraction.

* If user agreement is broken outside of regular academic class time, the administrator may have the option to revoke privileges on a time restriction basis to enable student to receive class credit in classes that require computer access.
